Responsibilities:

Medical Affairs:

- Provide materials for continuous medical and product trainings for Marketing and Sales force teams;
- Provide medical/scientific support to dossier preparation for pricing, reimbursement, prescription guidelines, RMP countries implementation;
- Build professional relationship with leading HCPs, partners and customers;
- Speaker training and speaker engagement in scientific events including advisory boards, round table meetings, medical education meetings etc.;
- Provide Medical information for patients, HCPs or other stakeholders in his/her area of responsibility;
- Support scientific partnerships/collaborations with external stakeholders;
- Ensure Medical compliance – review and approval of educational, promotional and non-promotional materials and events, adherence to Industry Codes of Practice.

Pharmacovigilance:

- Handle Individual Case Safety Reports and literature reports;
- Coordinate and monitor additional PV and risk minimization activities at country level, as requested by local CA;
- Ensure appropriate distribution of relevant documents to CA;
- Track local additional PV and risk minimization activities;
- File and archive relevant local documentation;
- Interaction with local CA for submission of safety information or answering to CA questions;
- Monitors local safety regulation;
- Follow up for contractual agreements with partners;
- Support Market research programs;
- Ensure PV training to employees/ external partners.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Candidates must possess Medical Degree, preferably with clinical knowledge of assigned therapeutic areas;
- Solid industry experience in Medical Affairs;
- Understanding of pharmaceutical industry guidelines and local regulatory framework;
- Excellent interpersonal skills related to management of scientific leaders and authorities;
- Communication skills and the ability to function within a team environment, collaborative problem solving approach within the team;
- Simultaneously handling multiple tasks and working under pressure;
- Works to develop new skills and abilities;
- Presentation skills;
- Fluency in English;
- Clear driving licence.
